

Graduation Course Requirements for Vocational Track (24 Credits Required)

The minimum graduation requirements for this track **does not** meet HOPE Scholarship rigor requirements. A HOPE Grant can be earned towards tuition at a technical college for students with a 2.0 GPA for students on this track.

*A student can take this track and still graduate with HOPE Scholarship as long as he/she maintains a 3.0 and takes 4 rigor courses (Chemistry, Advanced Senior Math, Spanish II, Anatomy, AP Government, Dual Enrollment, or AP Computer Science are all options)
